Vaasa, Finland

The “Transformative innovation in action” Forum, the 23rd World Alliance for Low Carbon Cities Forum, emphasizes international collaboration in the spirit of the EU missions and accelerates the co-implementation of the twin green & digital transition. The Forum is hosted in Vaasa, the Nordic energy capital and a forerunner in decarbonization. By working together with leading green tech companies such as ABB and Wärtsilä, Vaasa has become a leading energy innovation hub.

Transformative innovation calls for collaboration involving missions, policymakers, innovation agencies, regions, cities, researchers, and industry. This year’s Forum brings these perspectives together to better understand the dynamics of multi-level governance and the means of engaging industry in joint efforts, anchoring the discussions in practical experiences.

A feature of particular interest in Vaasa as an innovation hub is the Aurora Botnia ferry. The first day of the Forum is hosted aboard the Aurora Botnia ferry, the world’s most environmentally friendly passenger and car ferry which operates daily, between Vaasa and Umeå, and functions as a research laboratory for companies in Finland and Sweden. The second day of the Forum is held at one of Ostrobothnia’s most inspiring venues, the Wasa Innovation Center.


